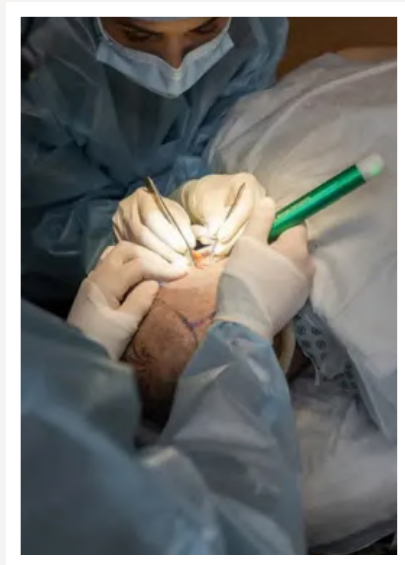
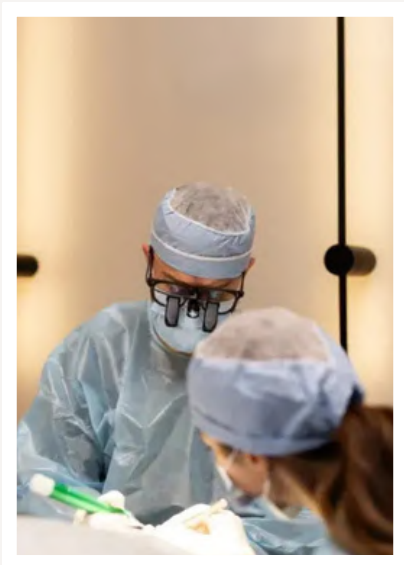
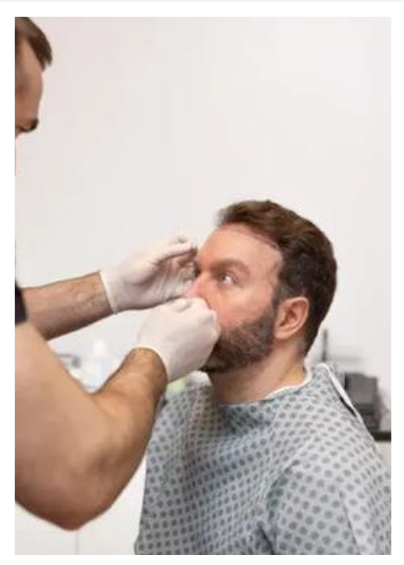

FUE Hair Transplant

Precision and care with comfort in mind.

Procedure: Follicular Unit Extraction (FUE) is a minimally invasive technique in which individual hair follicles are harvested from the donor area and implanted into thinning regions. This is a 5-8 hour procedure.

Step-by-Step:

1. Local anesthesia is applied to the donor and recipient areas.
2. Individual follicles are carefully extracted using micro-punch tools.
3. Follicles are implanted in the recipient area following natural growth patterns.
4. Post-procedure care instructions are provided for optimal results.

Ideal Candidates: Those seeking natural results without a linear scar, smaller to medium-sized cases, or individuals preferring shorter hairstyles.

Recovery: Most patients return to work within 2-3 days. Tiny dot scars at the donor site heal quickly. Mild redness or swelling may occur but typically resolves within a week.

Expected Results: Transplanted hairs shed temporarily before regrowth. Noticeable growth appears after 3-6 months, with full results in 9-12 months.

Eyebrow Transplant

Shape, definition, and confidence restored.

Procedure: Individual follicles are implanted into sparse eyebrows, angled and spaced to mimic natural growth. This takes 3-4 hours.

Ideal Candidates: Patients with over-plucked brows, age-related thinning, or hair loss from trauma or medical conditions.

Recovery: Mild redness or swelling resolves within 5-7 days. Grafted hairs shed initially and regrow over several months.

Expected Results: Symmetrical, full eyebrows that can be styled naturally within 12-18 months.

Beard Transplant

A beard that grows with you—permanently.

Procedure: Follicles from the scalp are implanted into sparse areas of the beard, following natural hair direction. This procedure takes 4-8 hours.

Ideal Candidates: Men who cannot grow a full beard or desire thicker, more defined facial hair.

Recovery: Redness and minor swelling may last 5-7 days. Most patients return to normal activities immediately.

Expected Results: Permanent, natural-looking beard that can be trimmed and styled within 12-18 months.

Non-Surgical Treatments

Hair restoration doesn't always require surgery. For patients who want to slow hair loss, stimulate new growth, or enhance the results of a transplant, non-surgical options can be an excellent choice. These treatments are minimally invasive, have little to no downtime, and are designed to support healthy, natural-looking hair growth while boosting overall scalp wellness. They are often recommended as a first step for patients in the early stages of hair loss or as a complementary therapy for those who have undergone surgical restoration.

Dr. Moleno offers several non-surgical options, each customized to meet the unique needs of the patient:

- Platelet-Rich Plasma (PRP) and Platelet-Rich Fibrin (PRF) therapy uses growth factors from the patient's own blood to stimulate dormant follicles and strengthen existing hair.
- Medication management includes FDA-approved solutions such as finasteride and minoxidil, tailored to help slow the progression of hair loss.
- Low-level laser therapy (LLLT) uses light energy to improve scalp circulation and follicle activity.
- Scalp micropigmentation offers a cosmetic solution by creating the look of fuller density or camouflaging thinning areas.

The benefits of non-surgical treatments are extensive. They can stimulate new growth, strengthen existing follicles, slow down or prevent further hair loss, and enhance the results of a hair transplant. Because these therapies require little to no downtime, patients can easily integrate them into their daily lives. PRP/PRF Therapy

Ideal Candidates: Early thinning or post-transplant patients.

Recovery: Minimal downtime; mild tenderness resolves in 24-48 hours.

Expected Results: Noticeable improvement in density after 3-6 monthly sessions, spaced 4-6 weeks apart.

Scalp Micropigmentation

Treatment: SMP replicates natural hair follicles via cosmetic tattooing to help fill in thinning or balding areas or create the look of a closely shaved head. This treatment is usually completed over 2-3 sessions lasting around 2-4 hours each.

Ideal Candidates: Non-surgical enhancement, scar concealment, or clean buzz-cut aesthetic.

Recovery: Mild redness for 24-48 hours; complete healing requires 5-7 days between treatments; touch-ups are recommended.

Expected Results: The results are immediate and realistic, providing long-lasting visual density.

How soon will I see results after surgery?

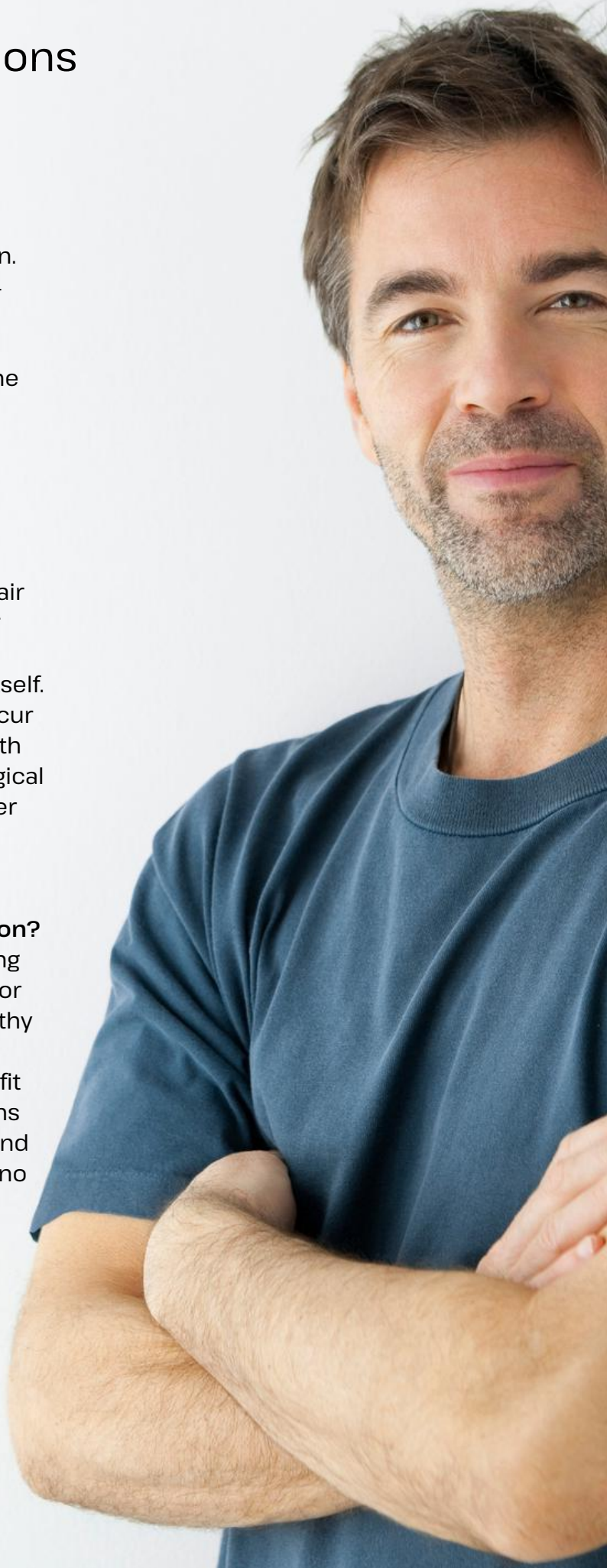
After a hair transplant, it's normal for transplanted hairs to shed within the first 2-4 weeks. This is part of the natural growth cycle and should not be a cause for concern. New hair growth typically begins around 3-4 months post-surgery, with noticeable improvement by 6-9 months. Full results, including density, texture, and natural hairline blending, are usually visible by 12 months. Individual growth timelines vary depending on age, hair type, and the number of grafts transplanted.


Are these procedures painful?

Patient comfort is a top priority at Moleno Hair Restoration. Local anesthesia is used during surgical procedures, so most patients feel minimal discomfort during the procedure itself. Some mild soreness or tenderness may occur afterward, but this is usually manageable with over-the-counter pain medication. Non-surgical treatments, like PRP therapy or low-level laser therapy, are virtually painless, with only mild sensations such as tingling or warmth.

Who is a good candidate for hair restoration?

Good candidates include adults experiencing thinning hair, receding hairlines, bald spots, or patchy facial hair. Patients should have healthy scalp tissue and realistic expectations for outcomes. Both men and women can benefit from hair restoration, though treatment plans differ based on hair type, hair loss pattern, and desired results. Will people notice my treatment?

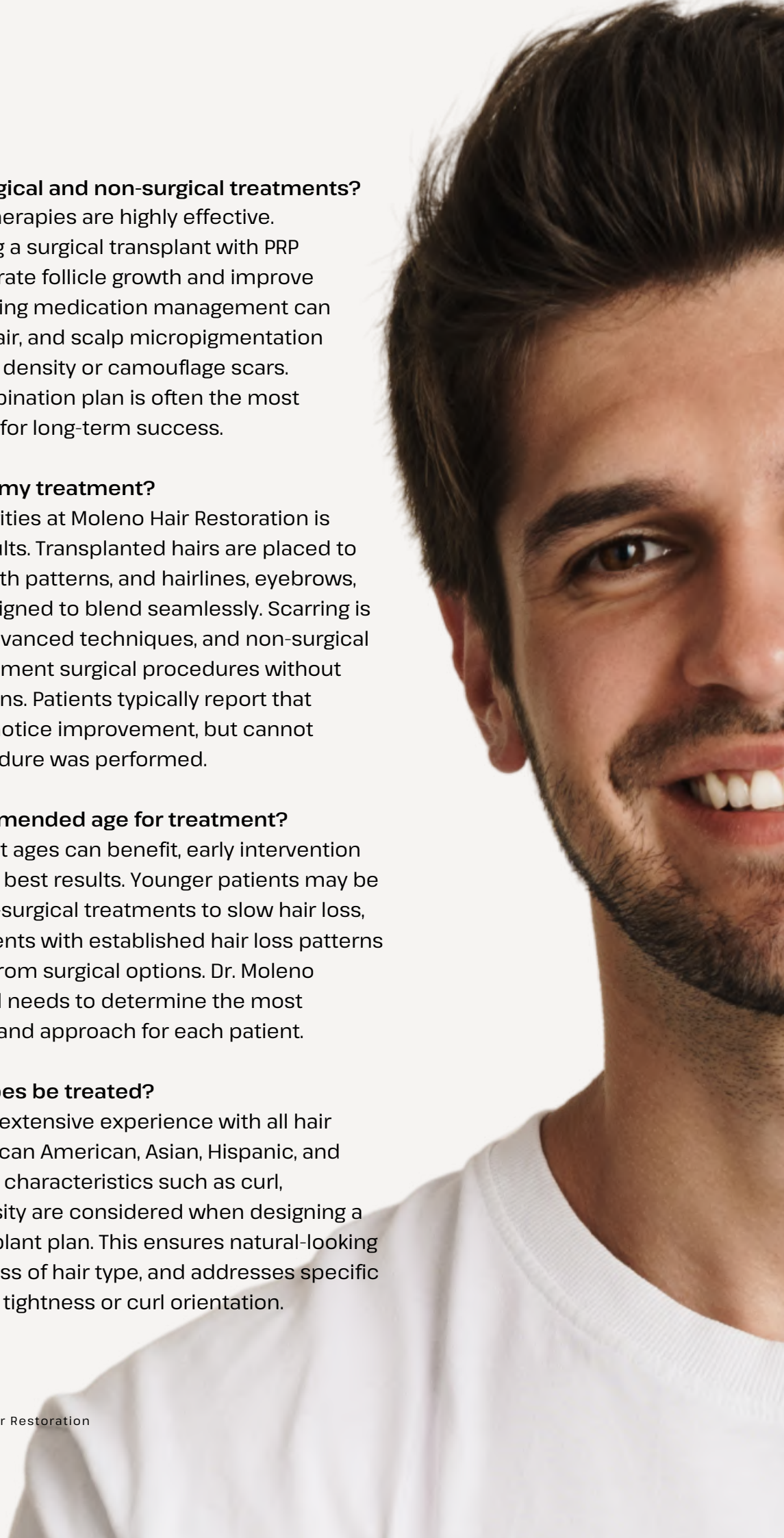
